Summary

- **Evacuation Orders in Effect** for the following towns in Mariposa County: Town of Coulterville, Hunters Valley, Bear Valley, Cathey's Valley, Bridgeport, Mormon Bar, Mount Boillion, Yaqui Gulch, Aqua Fria, Greely Hill (see the evacuations section for additional rural area evacuations)
- Evacuation order for the Town of Mariposa has been lifted.
- The fire has burned 74,083 acres and is 15% contained.
- There are impacts to power, water, communication, and hospital critical infrastructures.

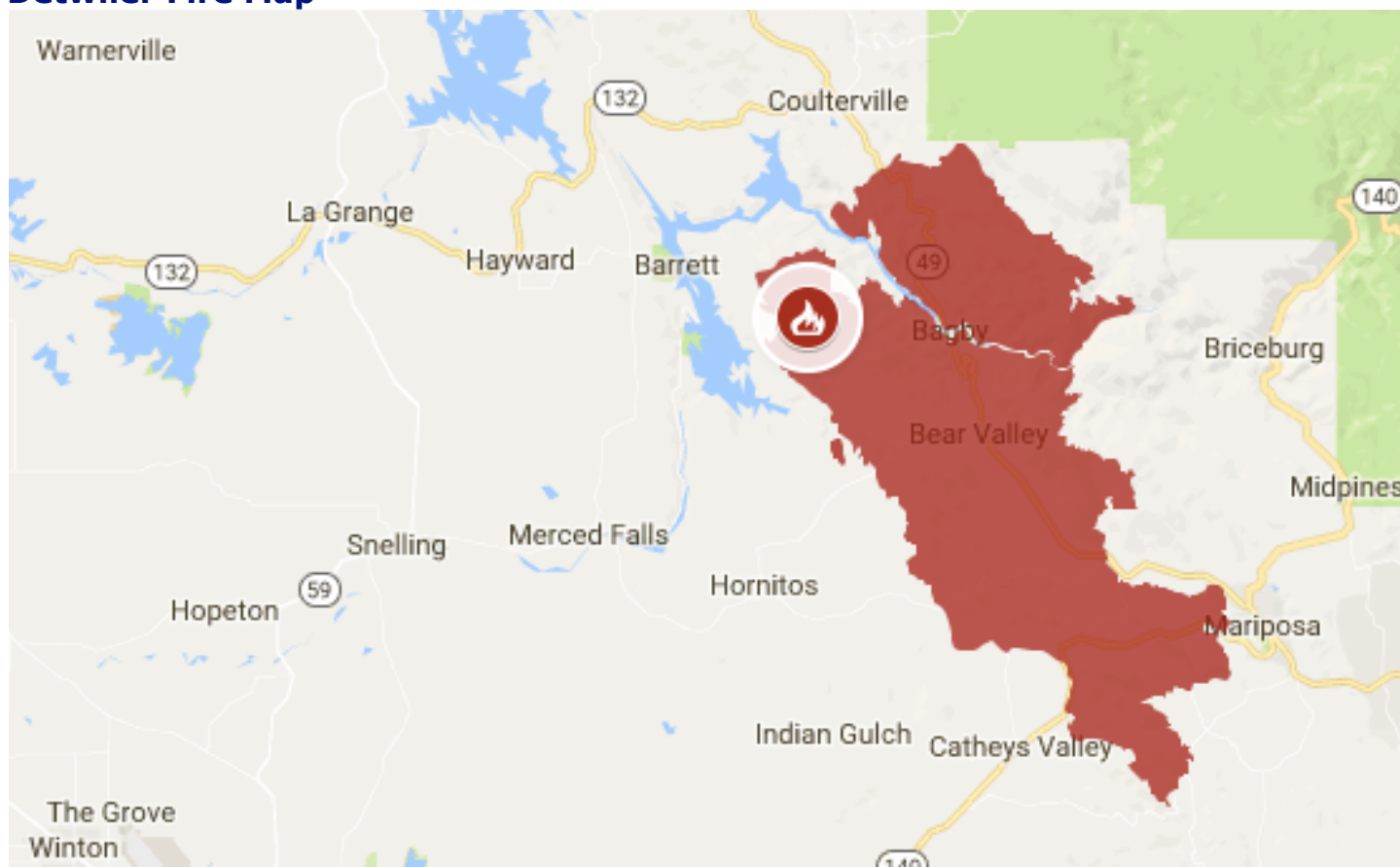

Critical Infrastructure Impacts

Power

- PG&E is advising 3,700 customers are currently without service due to the fire. There is no estimated time of restoral. (4)

Water

- Threat to Watershed, Merced River and Lake McClure. (4)
- Impact to Merced Irrigation District resources and Valley water users. (4)

Communications

- A Satellite COLT (Cell On Light Truck) deployed to the Mariposa County Fairgrounds to augment communications with suppression personnel. (4)
- Verizon and AT&T towers are down which has affected cell coverage. AT&T has brought in resources which have improved the cell, Verizon Wireless has boosted capacity to meet demand. (4)

Hospitals

- The John C. Fremont Hospital, 5189 Hospital Road, Mariposa, is sheltered in place. (4)
