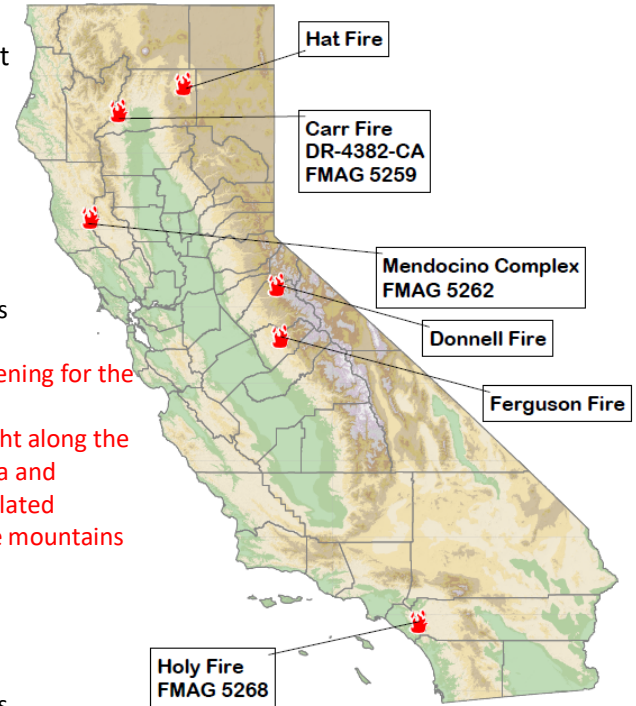

Schools Summary

- Most schools have scheduled start times to begin over the next two weeks. School districts in Lake, Shasta, and Riverside Counties have officially delayed their start date
- Five (+1) school districts are not open due to smoke; no mandatory evacuations or repopulation:
 - Riverside**
 - Menifee UESD (original start date was 8/8/18 and is currently delayed)
 - Perris ESD (original start date is 8/16/18 and is currently delayed)
 - Perris UHSD (original start date was 8/8/18 and is currently delayed)
 - Romoland ESD (original start date was 8/9/18 and is currently delayed)
 - Cornona-Norco USD (a year round school) has delayed the start date for 23 schools to 8/20/18
 - Mariposa**
 - Three of the 13 schools in Mariposa County - Yosemite Park High, Yosemite National Park El Portal and El Portal Elementary - located on two sites are now accessible. Staff will be working over the next week to meet the 8/21/18 scheduled start date
